

Bible Class Teaching Challenge

PURPOSE: To encourage young people to develop creative teaching skills.

PROCESS

Each participant will:

- Follow the guidelines stated below and adhere to the instructions from their teaching mentor.
- Submit reports and forms for this event to the teaching mentor. Mentors are responsible for submitting completed materials before the challenge deadline. Students are encouraged to submit their materials well before that time.

The Church Coordinator will:

- Assist students in finding teaching mentors.
- Assure that student, teaching mentor, and any other person concerned, such as parents, are informed of the requirements.
- Assure that the teaching mentor turns in all completed materials before the Challenge Deadline to the Church Coordinator.
- Keep a record of all medals earned by participants and fill out the form on the website requesting the appropriate Bible Class Teaching medals for your congregation.

GUIDELINES

Participant Eligibility

- There are two grade levels in this event: Grades 3-6 and Grades 7-12.
- This is an individual event, not a team event.
- Participants must be at least three years older than the class he or she is teaching unless special circumstances do not allow this. (Please explain any such circumstances.)
- Participants may teach a variety of situations such as VBS, Day Camp, Children's Worship hour, or Bible Class.
- Class material may be related to the MWLTC theme or Bible Bowl book, but this is not required. If a curriculum is already in place, participants are strongly encouraged to consider using that established curriculum.

Submitting Material (Certification & Other Material)

- Each participant must complete the certification form (2 pages) and turn it in to the local church coordinator before **the challenge deadline**
- The church coordinator will keep a record of all medals earned by participants and fill out the form on the website requesting the appropriate Bible Class Teaching medals for their congregation by **the challenge deadline**.
- The certification forms do NOT need to be mailed in to MWLTC.
